Community Youth Against Violence

Camera Campaign Initiative is designed to

- Help Police Department reduce gun violence and all crimes
- Gives citizens a sense of security
- Identify suspects in lieu of eyewitness
- Cause suspect to think about committing crimes



Data shows

60% OF PEOPLE WHO COMMITTED CRIMES SAID THAT THEY WOULD HAVE THOUGHT TWICE ABOUT COMMITTING THE CRIME, IF THEY KNEW THEY WERE UNDER CAMERA SURVEILLANCE.

“SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING” IS JUST NOT WORKING ANY LONGER. OUT OF FEAR, COMPLACENCY OR JUST IMMUNE TO CRIME IN THEIR NEIGHBORHOODS, PEOPLE JUST AREN'T TALKING ANYMORE.

CAMERAS PLAY A MAJOR ROLE IN OFFERING SAFETY ON A DAILY BASIS AND DURING EVENTS BOTH BIG AND SMALL.

What are the Advantages of Closed Circuit TV (CCTV)?



CCTV cameras are effective in preventing crime in public places. When the criminal knows they are under surveillance, it can deter them from committing the crime, possibly saving an innocent life.

Helped New Orleans Police Department identify and apprehend a murder suspect by using high-definition images of the probable killer in a parking garage during a drug deal murder.

CCTV security cameras were even more effective in deterring crime in Baltimore and the social benefits exceeded costs by 50 percent.

The more CCTV cameras in an area, the more chance of reducing crimes.



CCTV and the Police

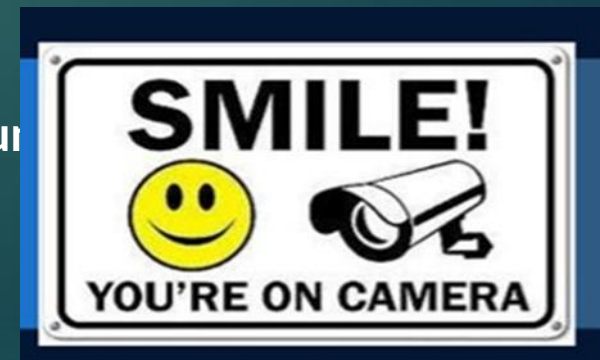
Special projects crime reduction are more successful—especially when police are directly involved

Police monitoring of the camera in the control room leads to quicker response of an active crime scene.

CCTV more successful when working in conjunction with other crime deterrent methods
