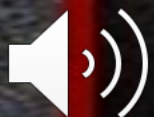

WHAT IS THE TEEN CURFEW ORDINANCE ?

Teen Curfew is an ordinance that prohibits individuals under the age of 17 to be out in the streets unsupervised by their parent or guardian after 11:00p.m.-6:00a.m. on weekdays and 12:00a.m.- 6:00a.m. on weekends.



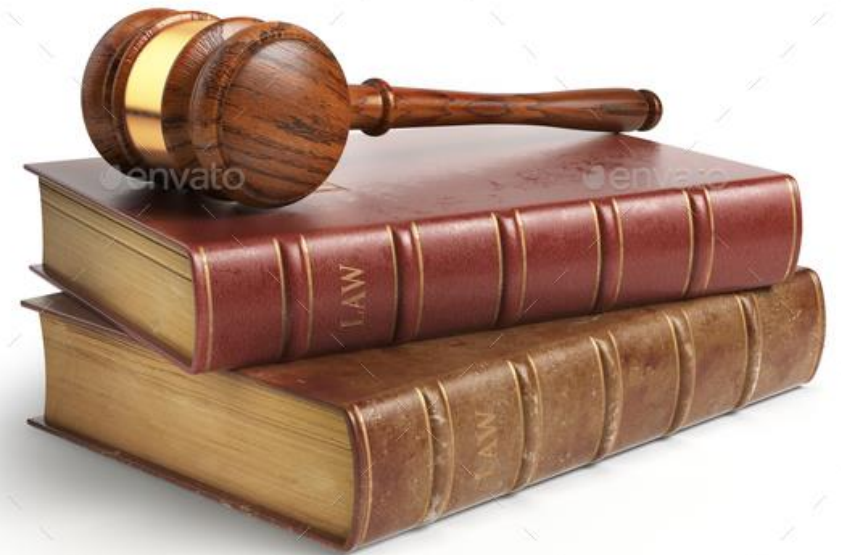


WHAT ARE THE EXCEPTIONS TO THE TEEN CURFEW?

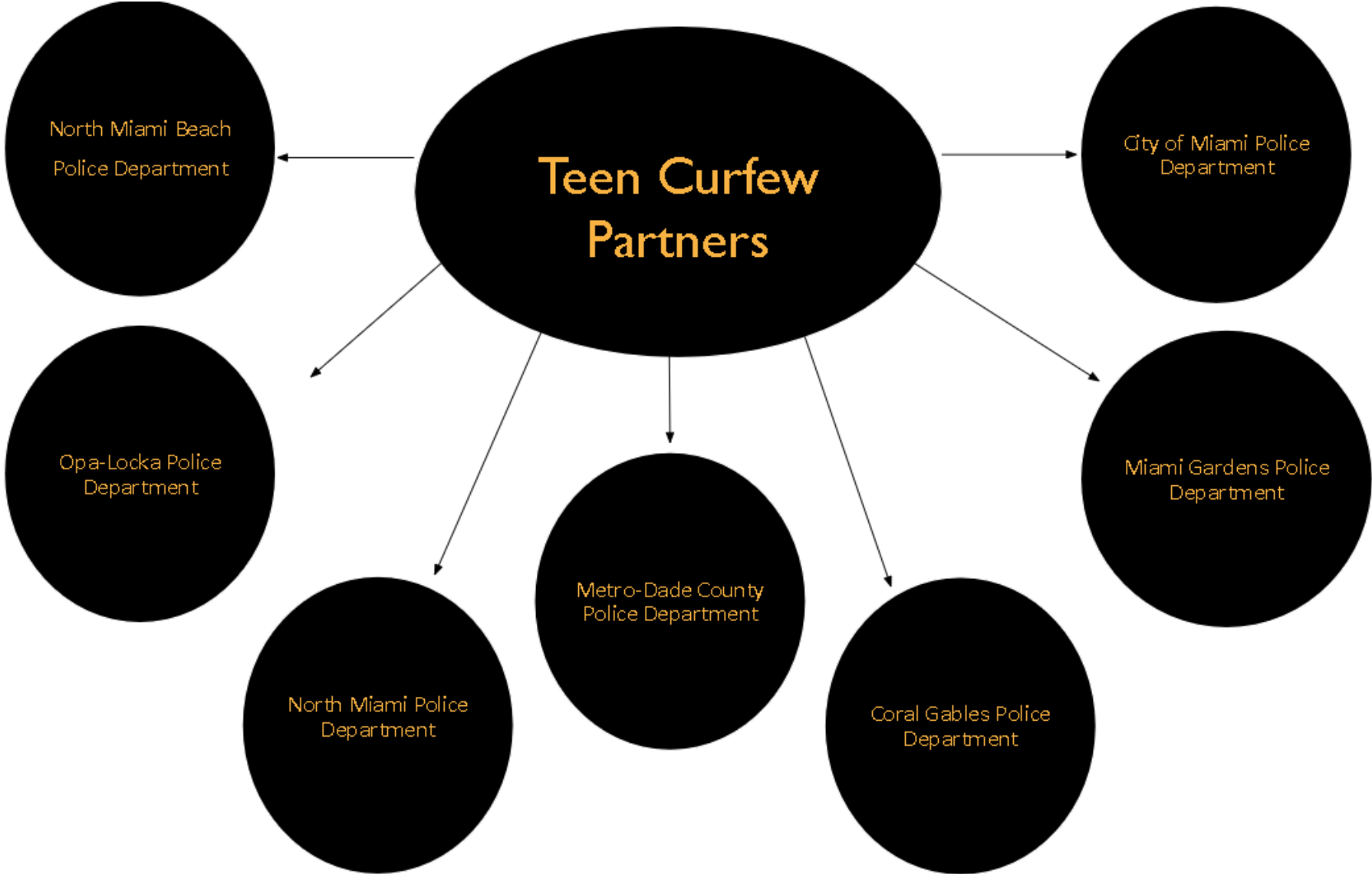
- The only teens excluded from the Teen Curfew are those who are going or returning from work and those who are traveling.
- Teens who are caught committing a crime while violating the teen curfew will not be taken to any of the drop off points, but will be handled by law enforcement and they will decide how to proceed.

WHAT ARE THE CONSEQUENCES?

- Any child caught breaking the Teen Curfew Ordinance will immediately be picked up by a law enforcement officer. The parent or guardian will then be notified, and the child will be taken to the nearest drop off point.
- Parents could face up a five-hundred dollar fine when the child is found to have broken the ordinance multiple times.



OPERATION TEEN CURFEW



WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE YOUTH IS TAKEN TO THE NEAREST DROP OFF POINT?

Step 1: Parent or guardian will be notified by law enforcement officer that the child is being picked up and must report to the to the nearest police station.

Step 2: Youth's basic information will be registered by the law enforcement officer and the information will be placed in a data base.

Step 3: The parent, guardian or an adult over the age of 21 years old must present a valid ID when picking up the youth and will have to fill out a release form.



WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE YOUTH IS TAKEN TO THE NEAREST DROP OFF POINT?

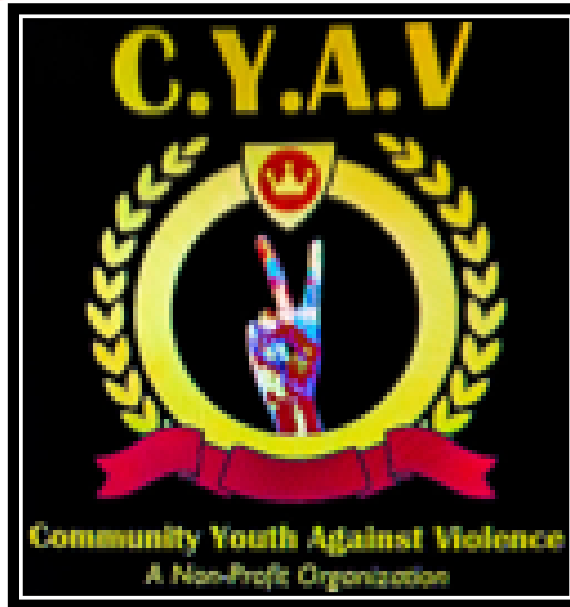
Step 4: There will be a follow up within 24-72 hours in which the parent or guardian will be notified that a CYAV counselor will do a home visit and complete an observation and well-detailed assessment.

Step 5: Once the observation and assessment is completed, the C.Y.A.V. counselor will determine what resources will be provided for the well being of the child and parents' needs.



WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE TEEN CURFEW?

The purpose of the Teen Curfew Ordinance is to decrease juvenile crime, and advocate to end gun violence in our communities. Our mission is to create an effort to develop a relationship and accountability among parents and children.

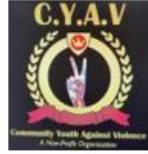
